2. TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

The organization is created by the host's rules in accordance with official regulation of the Czech Army "Vsevojsk-4-2" (Schema of Shooting from of Small Arms and Weapons of Combat Vehicles) with partial adaptation of training conditions. The general regulations of sport shooting activities and Technical Rules of Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic shall also be taken into account.

2.1. EVENTS AND SPECIFICATION OF THEIR FULFILLMENT

2.1.1. Shooting from the army pistol CZ model 82 (caliber 9 x 18 mm):

- number of cartridges for sighting: 3,
- number of cartridges for competition: 10,
- target: unprotected lying figure with circles (target no. 4),
- distance to target: 20 meters,
- time for fire: 60 sec,
- position for fire: standing (both-handed);

2.1.2. Shooting from the army automatic rifle model 58 (caliber 7,62 x 39 mm):

Task: Loading of 9 (nine) cartridges, lying position without support.

Part A:

- number of cartridges: 3,
- fire mode: single gunshots,
- target: unprotected lying figure (3x foldable target no. 6),
- distance to target: 100 meters,

Changing of fire mode to "multiple fire" and continued shooting.

Part B:

- number of cartridges: 6,
- fire mode: short series of gunshots,
- target: forward running figure (3x foldable target no. 8),
- distance to target: 200 meters,

Time for fire: unlimited – measured for whole task from signal of timer.

Whole task (article 2.1.2.) will be carried out two times. The first one (Part A + Part B) will be considered as initial firing of weapon with indicative time measurement. The second one (Part A + Part B) will be consider as competition and score will be write down to competitor's record. Formula = hit to target minus time. Minimum value is 0 (zero). Hit of figure is equal to 15 (fifteen) points.

2.2. COMPETITION RULES

2.2.1. Specific regulations

Competition is an international event of three-member teams of Czech Armed Forces and reservists from partner European countries. Official Czech Army weapons are used.

The competition has two parts: **a) shooting from the army pistol CZ model 82,**
 b) shooting from the army automatic rifle model 58.

Item a) Every shooter has one target and a weapon for carrying out of whole task. Competitive team shoots at the same time. Telescopes or proofreaders are not allowed.

Item b) Every shooter has a set of targets. Each member of the team shoots step by step in both tasks (initial firing). After that is course repeated as real competition with time measurement for each member of the team.

The capacity of the shooting competition is 120 competitors (one team from each unit of the Czech Active Reservists and one team from each district of the Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic). From abroad may participate two teams from every country. The deadline for registration is unchangeable. Organizer of the competition reserves the right to assemble starting list to full capacity in the order of applications received. If capacity is free, it is also possible to offer participation to other interested parties up to full capacity. Organizer has obligation to inform registered teams about outcome of final choice of competitive teams. All members of the competitive teams are obliged to participate on smooth running of the competition in accordance with instructions of organizers.

Protests can be submitted to Chief Referee only in written form during the competition but no later than 15 minutes after publishing of the final scores. Protest will be judged by Competition Committee and its decision is definitive.

All participants of the competition are required to respect this rules and instructions of organizers. Director - Organizing Committee Chairman has authority to discontinue participation on the competition in the case of serious breaking the rules. For example: breaking the rules during the firing, unauthorized incoming to military area by car, etc). In this case, the funds are not refundable.

2.2.2. Generally applicable rules

Contestants will ensure insurance individually (except employees of MOD). Basic medical security is realizing by Military Dispensary Jince.

2.2.3. Instruction in safety

All shooters have obligation to respect commands of Control Group Commanders; notably the safe handling of weapons and compliance with safety rules. Manipulation with weapon is possible only in accordance with command. Gun barrel must be aimed to determined firing sector. In the case of problem with weapon the competitor raises his hand. Based on this signal commander will take further steps.

Ears and eye protectors are obligatory.

It is forbidden to consume alcoholic beverages, drugs or medication affecting attention.

The organizer is not liable for damage to personal property or health of participants.

Every participant must respect safety precautions; he holds full responsibility for that. Violation of safety instructions is punishable by disqualification.

3. REGULATIONS OF ASSESSMENT

The assessment will be done in accordance with “General Rules of Sports Shooting Activity of Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic”.

The competition results are assessed in two categories – teams and individuals.

Team ranking is determined by summation of the scores of all team members in both disciplines (i.e. pistol and automatic rifle). In the case of parity of points is decisive better summation in discipline “pistol”.

In addition, assessment of individuals and teams from abroad will be done separately from assessment of all individuals and teams.

Individuals are assessed separately in every discipline. There is decisive higher value of points in discipline “pistol” in the case of parity of points.

Assessment in discipline “automatic rifle”

Result = points minus time. Every hit to figure = 15 points. Time is measured in hundredth of a second. Not switching to mode “series of gunshots” is considered as procedural mistake. This situation is punished by 10 second for each bang.

For performances achieved in the competition will be awarded performance category:

Category	Pistol	Automatic rifle
Expert	at least 98 points	hit of 6 figures in 25 seconds
Sharpshooter	at least 95 points	hit of 6 figures in 30 seconds
Marksman	at least 93 points	hit of 5 figures in 30 seconds

3.1. Individuals – ranking in disciplines:

- **Pistol** – from the first to third position – medals and certificates,
- **Automatic rifle** – from the first to third position – medals and certificates.

3.2 Teams – overall ranking:

- **1st position** – cup from Prague Regional Military HQ Commander (one for team), cup from Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic Chairman (on for team), medals and certificates,

- **2nd and 3rd positions** – cups from Prague Regional Military HQ Commander (one of them for every team), cups from Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic Chairman (one of them for every team), medals and certificates.

3.3 Foreign individuals and teams – separate assessment of total placings:

- **1st, 2nd and 3rd team** – cups from Association of Reservists of the Czech Republic Chairman (one of them for every team), certificates,
- **1st, 2nd and 3rd individual** – medals, certificates;

4.2. Weapons and ammunition are arranged by host. Own weapons and ammunition are not allowed. **It is forbidden to enter with own weapons and ammunition** in the area of the competition.

4.5. Dress Code:

- Czech military persons in active duty and persons subsumed in Czech Army Active Reservist Units – uniform model 95,
- the others – suitable sport or club outfit.

4.6. Accommodation:

Accommodation is provided at the hotel (Sporthostel Scandinavia**, Drnovská 19/43, 161 00 Praha 6 – Ruzyně). **The accommodation for two nights is included to the price for foreign competitors.**

4.7. Boarding:

Boarding is included to the price for foreign competitors as follows:

- Saturday 18 May 2019:
 - a) breakfast and lunch (self-service in Military Training Area Jince),
 - b) dinner in Prague local restaurant (nearby the hotel).
- Sunday 19 May 2019:
 - a) breakfast at the hotel.

4.8. Presence of foreign competitors:

- on Friday 17 May 2019 from 16:00 hrs. to 20:00 hrs. (in the hotel lobby), or
- on Saturday 18 May 2019 from 07:30 hrs. to 08:45 hrs. (in Military Training Area Jince).

To log into the competition (submission of an application form) when presence is not possible.

4.9. Transport and arrivals:

Transport to the place of presence by own vehicles.

The parking area is in front of entrance to the Military Training Area Jince. The entrance to the military area by private cars is not allowed.

People staying at the hotel can use the hotel outdoor parking lot. **For all competitors is provided bus transfer (free of charge) from the hotel to the military area and back. Departure of the bus is on Saturday 18 May 2019 at 06:30 hrs.**

4.13. Price:

The price is 50 EUR per person. 5.1. Participant's obligations:

- To abide by **Operating Regulations of Shooting Range** and declared safety instructions. Competition participants take part in the competition at their own risk and are fully responsible for their damage or injury, which confirm their signature on the attendance register.
- To pay the price. **Price for foreign participants is due in EUR in cash at the presence** (payment cards are not accepted).

5.2. The organizer reserves the right to alter and amend the regulations. In case of cancellation of the event by the organizer or cancel the participation by the contestant due to changes in prices of these services, the participant obtains competition prepaid amounts in full.
